Seal Cracks and Holes in the Houses

Any cracks or gaps are ideal hiding places for pests. The main entry points for moisture that results in dampness and serves as breeding grounds for pest infestations are cracks in the bathroom or beneath the sink.

Many homes have improperly sealed gaps around the door and window frames or deteriorated sealant. Pests can enter through these openings. Therefore, immediately close any gaps like this using a sealant or anything similar if you find any.

Keep the Kitchen Clean

Summers in Kolkata are also known for sporadic nor'wester (Kalbaisakhi) that can bring torrential rain to some locations. These showers cause the plant tubs or buckets that are left outside in the open to fill with water. Make sure to completely empty these buckets and tubs after it rains.

Keep Your Bathroom Clean

The bathroom is one of the most relaxing places in your home during the summer. Insects and pests are the same way. This is due to the fact that it is among the coolest and moistest areas of the house for survival.

Family hygiene demands that bathrooms be kept spotless and free of pests. To keep it dry and make sure the bathroom has adequate ventilation, use a proper exhaust. Regularly clean your bathroom with disinfectants to keep pests at bay.

Keep Your Garden Tidy

Another favorite spot for pests to reside is the garden. Maintain a short grass area. You can control the plant heights by constantly trimming and keeping an eye on the garden. Keep Excess Moisture Away
