

Surrogacy in Albania: Key Things To Consider!

Although surrogacy has been practiced in Albania for years, it is still not regulated within this part of the world. Due to this, the country is able to provide programs to heterosexual couples, whether they are married or not, as well as single males.

The fact that its costs are far lower than those in the United States is one of the key benefits this nation provides to every child seeking parent. Moreover, numerous couples pick this location due to its geographic proximity to other European countries.

Surrogacy registration in Albania

A birth certificate produced by the clinic is required for the civil record registration of the child by the intending parents after birth. Since <u>surrogacy in ALBANIA</u> is unregulated, both the biological father and the surrogate mother must be listed on the birth certificate in order for it to be registered in the civil registry.

At the same time, we will eventually get the waiver of the <u>surrogate mother albania</u>, which we could later require in our country of origin if we wish our partner or spouse to adopt the kid.

Surrogacy process in Albania

- As is the case in the majority of other nations that use surrogacy, gestational or complete surrogacy—that is, the practice in which the surrogate mother does not contribute genetic material—is being used in ALBANIA.
- The genetic material comes from either the parents voluntarily or from a donor at surrogacy clinic in Albania. Since there is no court sentence in this nation and paternity is established by filiation, the donor utilized can only be an egg donor. The father must also demonstrate his biological kinship to the kid. The donor may be selected or remain anonymous.
- The donors are typically healthy women between the ages of 18 and 26 who have undergone rigorous medical examinations to ensure their safety.



What is the cost of surrogacy in Albania?

The cost of a surrogacy in Albania majorly depends on a list of factors like number of IVF cycles used during the treatment, egg or sperm donor used medical cost for the surrogate and so on. The type of program offered by the <u>surrogacy clinic in Albania</u> further holds a big impact on the cost of surrogacy in ALBANIA.

Surrogacy in Albania: Benefits!

- Surrogacy in Albania can be pursued by married couples, single males, and unmarried couples.
- Process costs are significantly cheaper than in Florida, USA. Most programs have a total cost between 61,000 and 80,000 euros.
- Availability of egg donation programs programs that promise an infinite number of in vitro fertilization attempts and embryo transfers, at a certain cost.
- NGS programming with sex selection is a possibility.

• Some programs offer a variety of insurances, such as health insurance for the surrogate mother, insurance in the event that the surrogate mother or donor passes away, insurance in the event that the program is resumed after the death of the child, etc. so that, no matter what, you can realize your desire to have children.

Observations

You receive a birth certificate from The Hague with the apostille rather than a sentence. The other spouse will have to adopt the kid after she arrives in her country because the child will be brought in the father's name.

Summing it up

Surrogacy in Albania is legal. It doesn't matter if you are a foreigner or not, as long as you have the money to pay for the procedure and are physically able to carry the baby, you can undergo an Albania surrogacy program. It doesn't matter whether the surrogate is Albanian or not. All that matters is that you are physically able to complete the pregnancy.

Regardless of where you're from, you will still need to get a visa prior to traveling there to undergo this procedure. You can contact the embassy or consulate of Albania in your home country if you don't know which country issued your passport.
