History

Jodhpur became based in 1459 by using Rao Jodha, the Rathore ruler of the Marwar country. Initially, the town become referred to as Marwar but put up Rao Jodha took over the area, it came to be referred to as Jodhpur. The Rathores were in the beginning from Kannauj from where they had been pushed out by Afghans. Later, they managed to settle in Mandore which served as a capital until they moved to Marwar.
