

## Planning a visit to Kanha, Madhya Pradesh?

This article is about my trip experience and the services that I got from the hotel where I stood. Kanha is famous for its wildlife and natural beauty. You can spot these animals when you enter the Kanha National Park such as Bengal Tiger, Chital, Gaur, Barasingha, Indian roller, etc. So my trip plan to Kanha was for 4 days and it's not like I am bragging or anything but those were the memorable four days that I spent there with my family. I will cherish those moments for my entire life. On the 1st day, we visited Gwalior which is famous for its Gwalior Fort, Rajwada palace. We spent two days visiting Gwalior where on the first day, we visited Gwalior fort and its surrounding areas, check out the food there, visited the temple which is made up of red sandstones which has carvings of horses with chariots. This fort is built by Raja Man Singh Tomar which increases the value of this state and shows its ancient lineage. The pillars will have ancient carvings on them that will definitely catch your eye when you visit this place. On our second day, we visited Rajwada Palace, which is famous for its royal palace and it is situated in the middle of Madhya Pradesh and it is a symbol of Rajwadhas, who was known as the warriors and rich class for their wealth. When you enter this palace, there is a big entrance which has humongous gates that you can't shake even if you try. Inside the palace, you will see things that you usually see in movies and these palaces have inside. There is a large number of gardens inside there which have trees of different types. These trees are home to these small animals like squirrels, ants, birds, etc. There is a big courtyard where the king used to call his people and ask for their problems. There are way too many halls inside this palace and it shows the royalty these Rajawadha's used to have back in those days. On our 3rd day, we visited the famous Kanha National Park and its surrounding area. When we started our voyage, we first visited the Mukki Gate, which is a tourist destination for Hotels and Resorts in Kanha. From there we went to Kanha National Park which is famous for many wild animals but the center of attraction for this place is the Bengal Tiger which is loved by children as well as adults. The area of Kanha is separated into two parts Hallon and Banjar. There are different flora species around 1000 species you can find here. Some of the famous trees that you can spot are Sal, Mahua, Bamboo. Some of the famous faunas that you will find are Beeeaters birds, Grey hornbills, Tigers, Leopard, Foxes. All these animals are the reason for Kanha be a famous spot for tourists & travelers. At night we stayed at **Vanya Resort**, which is in Kanha, and rest there on the family-size bed. The next day, our last day we continued our trip and see all the remaining sights that we weren't able to visit on our third day. We did the Jungle Safari at night which was a sight to watch. The lights around the forest area brighten the whole spot and we clicked some pictures there and had something to eat. The experience
