



How To Upload Your iOS App On The App Store?

Steps on How To Upload Your App

1. Sign Up For Apple Developer Program

The very first step is to sign up for the Apple Developer Program. The interface gives you access to TestFlight, app analytics, and certification tools. This platform is where you register your devices and create developer profiles.

2. Create App Store Listing

Next, you sign up for the App Store Connect. You need to carry out the following tasks here:

- Create a new app by clicking the + button.
- Fill in the required information such as App name, Primary language, build ID, etc.
- Next, create a product page. You need to upload app previews, app screenshots, promotional texts, and the relevant URLs.
- You may need to fill some optional forms depending on your app, such as additional app reviews, content rights, app clips, etc.

- Finally, you need to fill out the pricing section if you're pricing your app or it has any in-app purchases.
- In the end, click Save.

3. Upload Your App Using Xcode

To upload your app, you need to install Xcode from the App Store. Use Xcode as follows:

- You need to archive your app. Select General iOS Device. Then click Product >>> Archive. This step will take some time.
- After the archive is complete, a new window will pop up. Select the Distribution Method. Choose iOS App Store.
- Xcode will run validations to remove any bugs. If it finds any errors, you will have to go back to coding.
- If there are no errors, Xcode will export your app build to the Appstore.

4. Submit For Review

Once Xcode has exported your app build, click Submit for Review, and you are done!

Cost of Uploading Your App to the Appstore

Sadly, uploading your app to the app store is not a free process. You need to purchase the Apple Developer Program subscription. It is an annual 99\$ fee and allows you to submit your app for distribution.
