Gold Britannia coins are a billion British coins issued by the Royal Mint in gold since 1987, silver since 1997, and platinum since 2018. Coin patterns depicting various portraits of Britannia portrayed as a woman in the United Kingdom.

Gold Britannia contains a troy ounce of gold and has a face value of £ 100. Gold Britannias are also issued in half, quarter, and one-tenth sizes of a troy ounce and have a face value of £ 50, £ 25, and £ 10 respectively. In 2013 two additional sizes were introduced, a five-ounce coin with a face value of £ 500, and a fraction of a 20-cent face value.

The Britannia silver coins contain a troy ounce of silver and have a face value of £ 2. Silver Britannias are also issued in half, quarter, and one-tenth sizes of a troy ounce and at face value of £ 1, 50p, and 20p respectively. As gold coins in 2013 introduced two additional sizes, a five-ounce coin with a face value of £ 10, and a half-size one and a face value of 10p.

As of 2013 gold coins have a millesimal fineness of 0.9999 (or 24-carat gold). Until 2012 gold coins had a millesimal fineness of 0.917 (91.7% or 22-carat gold) non-gold part was copper until 1989 and silver from 1990.

The Royal Mint is fully owned by Her Majesty's Treasury and welcomes her for being the oldest mint in the world. Named since 1987, British Britannia gold coins contain 1 oz of gold and have a guaranteed face value of 100 British pounds. The 2020 edition contains a troy ounce of 0.999 pure gold.
