Select the layer to animate and set keyframes to define movement, opacity, or scaling over time. Preview the animation to make sure transitions are smooth and visually appealing.

Add Motion Effects

Enhance your animation by applying motion effects like easing, blurs, or color corrections. Sync these effects with your animation to create a more dynamic and professional look.
