

# How to take your professional headshot: A complete guide

A portrait may appear out of balance if the subject is too close to the edge of the picture. It's crucial to consider the lighting when taking a portrait. The best option is natural light, but it can be challenging to manage. Try to locate a spot shaded from the sun if you are taking a portrait outside. Use a window as your natural light source if you are taking a picture inside. Use a soft light source if you must use artificial lighting.
