



What are the symptoms of premature labor?

Preterm labor (labor that occurs before 37 weeks of pregnancy) usually occurs unexpectedly, and the reason is unknown. Early labor symptoms, like typical labor symptoms, are

- Contractions (tightening of the abdomen) every 10 minutes or more



- Variation in vaginal discharge (a significant increase in the amount of discharge or leaking fluid or bleeding from the vagina)
- Pelvic pressure is the sensation that the baby is pushing down.
- Low, dull backache
- Cramps that feel like a menstrual period
- Constipation with or without diarrhea
