



Bharat Gaurav train: India's first private rail service begins service

The primary train to be worked among Coimbatore and Shirdi by a confidential administrator, under the "[Bharat Gaurav](#)" plan of the Indian Railways, was hailed off on Tuesday.

With this, the Southern Railway turned into the first zone in Quite a while to get the principal enrolled specialist co-op under the "Bharat Gaurav" plot, the Ministry of Railways said, adding that 1,100 travelers boarded the lady roundtrip administration from Coimbatore to Shirdi.

Coimbatore-based South Star Rail is the enlisted specialist co-op that works the train. The organization is essential for the aggregate gathering - Future Gaming and Hotel Services Pvt. Restricted has paid Rs 1 crore as a security store to Southern Railway for the rake with an organization of 20 mentors.

"Open doors for business people to investigate subject based the travel industry: First 'Bharat Gaurav' withdraws from Coimbatore to Shirdi," Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said in a tweet.

Under the 'Bharat Gaurav', the specialist co-ops will offer a comprehensive bundle to vacationers, including rail travel, inn convenience, touring game plan, visit to authentic or legacy destinations, and local escorts.

Prior to arriving at Shirdi, the train will stop at Tirupur, Erode, Salem Jolarpet, Bangaluru Yelahanka, Dharmavara, Mantralayam Road, and Wadi.

As per the public authority, the excursion rates are comparable to customary train ticket rates charged by the Indian rail lines.

The ticket likewise gives a restrictive VIP 'darshan' at Shirdi's Sai Baba Temple.
