



Desirable Qualities:

· Hardness of Bamboo Kitchen:

Quartz and feldspar minerals, the primary components of granite stone are regarded as tougher than steel, making granite one of the toughest materials discovered. Therefore, using Verde bamboo stone will ensure that your granite worktop is durable.




• Bamboo Kitchen Countertop are Scratch-Resistance



Your Verde Bamboo granite worktop is highly resistant to scratches. Even if it arises, its busily veined pattern will easily mask the scratches. This makes it a suitable option for kitchen worktops where sharp knives, forks, heavy appliances, pointed chopping boards etc may pose a risk to your countertop.

Heat Resistance

As Verde Bamboo Granite is formed from intense heat and pressure of natural forces under the earth's crust, the granite worktop fabricated from it is highly resistant to heat. In fact, a granite worktop is one of the best heat-resistant countertop options, available on the market. Hot objects directly from the oven will not cause immediate stains and scratches. However, prolonged keeping should be avoided with heat coasters and trivets to ensure the best look for worktops.



Bamboo Countertop Maintenance

Bamboo Style Countertop Sealing:


The Verde bamboo counter tops are more porous in some places than others, by nature. As a result, the slabs during the granite worktop fabrication process get initial sealing to make them evenly resistant to water-based and oil-based liquids that can penetrate and stain the pores. Ensure that after installation, annual sealing is done periodically, to keep your kitchen worktop in non-porous condition and best quality.



Cleaning Verde Bamboo Countertops:

Another important aspect of caring for your granite surface is using a cleaner designed for natural stone. Bamboo worktop and other surfaces are made of natural stone, and sealing them is just one step of the process. Some household cleaning products are not suitable to use on natural stone surfaces, and in reality, some cleaners remove the sealants from natural stone surfaces. Make sure to use a natural stone cleaner that won't make your sealer degraded.

Natural stone cleaners come in various types. One is the daily cleaner, intended to remove the stains, smudges, and food residue that typically accumulate on your Verde Bamboo countertops. The stain remover is another type of cleaner that is not needed as often. It is possible that you would need to use this type of cleaning agent if the sealer breaks down and oil- or water-based liquid gets into the pores of the granite. Such solutions remove stains by drawing the liquid into the stone's pores. Keeping the sealer replenished will reduce the need to use these stone cleaners.
