Foxes may hunt at any time of day, although they prefer to do it between the hours of dawn and dark. They stalk their prey while pursuing it. They have acute hearing, and their quick kill is enabled by their pouncing method.

In the winter, they listen for things moving beneath the snow or underground and catch them by pouncing and burrowing. When following larger prey, such as rabbits, they stalk until they are within striking distance but then wait until the rabbit flees.

The most common food items that foxes eat are small mammals, small birds, and seeds. They also like insects, reptiles, amphibians, other invertebrates, and vegetables and fruits, but they can't eat all of these things.

For example, foxes eat most insects but do not eat fish, reptiles, amphibians, or plants. They also would not eat seeds, which are difficult for them to digest fully.
