History

Constructed in 1611 AD, the **Fort of Khejarla** was conceived with the aid of the **Maharaja of Jodhpur** to honour the heroic services provided by **Maharaja Gopal Das Ji** inside the battle

against the Mughal Empire. It derives its call Khejarla from a Khejdi tree inside the village, which is thought to have blanketed the fortress while it turned into below attack from Mughal ammunition. The fortress changed into attacked three times by the Mughal Army, and on every occasion it became built again up once more, portraying the spirit of resilience among the Rajputs.

In that generation, Khejarla was a rich centre of Rajput royalty that blanketed eminent courtroom officials, property managers, hundreds of servants, numerous camels and horses for transportation, as well as a huge place of agricultural land. Officials at this courtroom had been quite regarded not best for his or her mind but for the honor, nobility and bravery they exhibited throughout instances of warfare.

Today, the historic citadel nevertheless exudes an aura of power and electricity, a reminiscence of its glorious past. After part of the Khejarla Fort was leased by means of Bhandari Heritage Pvt. Ltd (a subsidiary of Bhandari Export). In current years, it's been intricately evolved and made accessible to the public for visits and accommodation. The royal own family descendants from Jaisalmer, including the modern-day Maharaja of the castle Thakur Dileep Singh, still live in a non-public part of the shape.
