The ideal location

Are you planning a wedding in your town or at a location that is a wedding destination? Do you wish to have your wedding in Houston and in the suburbs like Woodlands?

Is the distance from the airport a factor? Affect your plans if you've got a lot of guests who are not local? Do you wish guests to stay at the venue, or are you open to the possibility of arranging transportation for them from the hotel they stay at to get there?

Which other things should I be looking for in the wedding location?

Although the factors listed above are essential, we've added a few additional tips to help you make the right choice:

How is the space feeling after it's set up

Be sure that the setup is manageable with reception tables, cocktail tables, chairs, and tables or even ceremony chairs. It is possible to inquire about their layout suggestions and check the possibility of peeking in to view the setup for an upcoming event.

Only attempt to fit in 10 chairs when usually there are only eight chairs at the table. Your guests will feel extremely conscious while they eat elbow-to-elbow.

What will the flow of guests be from eating and sitting to dancing

It is helpful to set up distinct areas for each event (e.g., the middle area can be considered the dancing floor lined with tables with guests with food and drinks placed around the edges).

If you attempt to move tables to create an area for dancing at the close of the evening and lose guests, you could lose them and make them leave early.

Do you have enough light?

Lighting can enhance the atmosphere and also the décor. If you plan on lighting that will illuminate during the daytime for the occasion, ensure there is sufficient sunlight, particularly for an event that is held during the daytime.

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
