

This can be particularly troublesome if you frequently drop things in your kitchen and bathroom because stained stones can be easily caused by colourful liquids on lighter-hued stones. Similar to interior limestone, outdoor limestone used around patios and pool decks may be exposed to various elements, chemicals, and heavy traffic.

Flooring



Maintenance of a Limestone Floor




