The GSM network providers offer an array of exciting deals and offer with their prepaid plans. If you are traveling to Bhutan all alone, you can choose the prepaid service plans.

Can You Get Tourist SIM Cards?

As for tourists, the prepaid SIM cards are available from authorized sources. All you need to do is fill the form for the SIM card. After this, you need to submit the copy of a passport size photo as well as a passport.

If you are an Indian tourist, your Voter ID card will do the necessities. You will require a passport size photograph and the form. The operators will check the network of your phone. If the phone supports 4 G, you will require a 4 G prepaid SIM. Otherwise, for 3 G phones, the 3

G SIM card will do.

Charges for a Suitable Prepaid Data Plan

You need to ensure that you choose a suitable data plan. For this purpose, you will have to check the [best prepaid plans](#) according to your requirements. You will require not more than Nu. 200 to buy the prepaid SIM card alongside a suitable data plan.

The prepaid SIM cards are available in three sizes. For macro SIM trays, you require macro SIM cards. For standard trays, you need the standard SIM card. And finally, for the nano trays, no other SIM cards except for nano SIMs would serve the purpose.
