

'The Last of Us' Star Melanie Lynskey Addresses Body-Shaming from America's Next Top Model



America's Next Top Model Season 1 defending champion Adrianne Curry recently sparked controversy on social media after he physically insulted Melanie Lynskey, star of the popular video game *The Last of Us*.

Curry criticized Lynskey's appearance in a recent magazine cover shoot in a now-deleted tweet, saying that her physique did not correspond to the role she played in the video game. "Her body says life of luxury... not post apocalyptic [sic] warlord. Where is Linda Hamilton when you need her?" Curry wrote in a tweet shared by Lynskey through a screenshot. Lynskey, who plays the ruthless survivalist in *The Last of Us*, was quick to respond to Curry's tweet, stating that the photo in question was taken for the cover shoot for InStyle magazine, and that the post-apocalyptic world I pointed out was too far away.

She also called out Curry for a lack of understanding and empathy for people who may be struggling with body image issues.

"I'm playing a person who meticulously planned & executed an overthrow of FEDRA," Lynskey wrote, pointing to the name of the military government influencing the United States twenty years after the fungus rebellion.

"I am supposed to be SMART, ma'am. I don't need to be muscly. That's what henchmen are for."

Hiatus from Twitter

Curry vented on her Facebook page in an attempt to justify her decision to stop using Twitter. She expressed her surprise in her post at the notion that actors and actresses would be unable to take criticism of the roles they play.

"Actors and actresses that cannot take criticism of characters they play is absurd to me. I acted in a film that people tore my character to SHREDS. I am not the character. It wasn't a direct attack. I survived," she said.

She has appeared in movies where her character has been criticized and she is not that character. He expressed dissatisfaction with what had led to bullying and harassment. Curry stated that she will not be returning to Twitter until Lynskey's fans stop harassing her for her opinion on a fictional character. She emphasized that her comments were not personal and were simply a criticism of a character in a movie or show.

"Now, I think I'll keep my NERD movie/show criticism to myself. These people take it too personally."
