



RR vs CSK Match Prediction- Who Will Win Today's IPL Match 68, IPL 2022

[RR vs CSK](#) Match Prediction- Who Will Win Today's IPL Match Between Rajasthan Royals And Chennai Super Kings, IPL 2022, Match 68. Rajasthan Royals and Chennai Super Kings will lock horns with each other in the final league encounter of IPL 2022. The RR vs CSK clash takes place on May 20 (Friday) at Brabourne Stadium in Mumbai.



Rajasthan Royals are led by Sanju Samson while Chennai Super Kings are led by MS Dhoni. RR has played 13 games so far in IPL 2022, winning 8 and losing 5. They have 16 points. Chennai Super Kings have won 4 matches and lost 9 out of 13, they have 8 points.

Rajasthan Royals defeated Lucknow Super Giants by 24 runs in their previous match of IPL 2022. Batting first in the match, Yashasvi Jaiswal slammed 41 runs to give a good start to Rajasthan Royals. Later, Sanju Samson scored 32 and Devdutt Padikka smacked 39 to take RR to 178-6.

With equally good bowling, RR restricted Lucknow Super Giants to 154-8 in 20 overs. Trent Boult gave an early blow to LSG, picking 2 wickets in the 3rd over. Prasidh Krishna and Obed McCoy also picked 2 wickets each. For LSG, Deepak Hooda was the lone good scorer with 59 runs.

Chennai Super Kings lost to Gujarat Titans in their last match of IPL 2022. CSK batted first in the match but could not post a fighting total. Ruturaj Gaikwad scored a slow knock of 53 runs

while N Jagadeesan smashed 39 runs, taking the scoreboard to 133-5 till the final ball.

Later, GT opener Wriddhiman Saha scored unbeaten 67 runs for the team and drove the team to victory by 7 wickets. Matheesha Pathirana picked 2 wickets and Moeen Ali picked 1 wicket for CSK but they could attack the opposition batsmen with a strong force.
