


Level-up your gaming Rig! - Take your playstyle to the next level with these gaming essentials.



Gaming as an industry has grown rapidly along the years and with the development of new and advanced games the requirement of Hi-Tech gaming peripherals have also increased. Many companies compete to make the best performing gaming peripherals. Here are some of the essentials that a gamer would require.

1. Laptop - Lenovo Legion Y540



Lenovo Legion series has introduced some of the best laptops to the gaming industry. Lenovo Legion Y540 is one of them. It is a well-built, high-performance gaming laptop. It was powered by an Intel Core i7-9750H CPU with 16GB of RAM and an Nvidia GeForce RTX 2060 with 6GB of video RAM. Storage came in the form of a 1TB Samsung PCIe NVMe solid-state drive. Users get an option to expand the storage by adding a 2.5-inch hard drive.

It performs incredibly well as an everyday laptop, running multiple applications is not a problem, switching between applications is smooth. The CPU and GPU performance is also very good.

As a gaming laptop, its performance is very good even at full HD resolution, there is no frame loss and the gaming experience is very smooth. The laptop is able to deliver 140 Frames per second even at high resolution.

The Legion Y540 comes with a 15.6-inch IPS LCD panel with Full HD resolution and 144Hz refresh rate. The display is sharp and colourful which will definitely enhance your gaming experience. The keyboard has flat, white-backlit keys, one might face some problems with the alignment of the keys as it is different from the usual alignment. As a result, you end up mistyping quite a bit. The laptop has a classy design which looks good and feels sturdy when held. At 2.3 kilogrammes, the Legion Y540 is quite heavy in the hands.

The legion has one of the weakest batteries among its competitors, the 52.5Wh three-cell internal battery on the Legion Y540 can run for approximately 1 hour, 40 minutes in a single charge.

2. Headphones - Sony MDRXB550AP



Affordable yet effective gaming headphones with awesome sound clarity with cushioned ear-pads for long-wearing comfort. It has a built-in remote and mic. It comes with a Tangle-free flat serration cord for easy usage. Playing first-person shooters? You can hear those footsteps coming in from a mile away! 3. Earphones - Sony MDR-XB55AP

2. Rainbow Six Siege



Tom Clancy's Rainbow Six Siege is an online tactical shooter video game developed by Ubisoft Montreal and published by Ubisoft. The game puts heavy emphasis on environmental destruction and cooperation between players. It's slow-paced and methodical. Each player assumes control of an attacker or a defender in different gameplay modes such as rescuing a hostage, defusing a bomb, and taking control of an objective within a room. This is where the Sony MDR-XB55AP or JBL E65BT can come in handy as it's critical to be able to hear any and all sounds headed your way.

3. Overwatch



Overwatch is a team-based multiplayer first-person shooter developed and published by Blizzard Entertainment. Described as a "hero shooter", Overwatch assigns players into two teams of six, with each player selecting from a roster of over 32 characters, known as "heroes", each with a unique style of play that is divided into three general roles that fit their purpose. Players on a team work together to secure and defend control points on a map or escort a payload across the map in a limited amount of time. Players gain cosmetic rewards that do not affect gameplay, such as character skins and victory poses, as they play the game.
