The CPU of a computer is a delicate part, so it is vital to protect it with a cabinet. The best CPU cabinet not only shields your computer with a hard shell but can also offer some appealing features.



A <u>pc cabinet</u> is an enclosed space with built-in, fixed, or detachable side panels and doors. Cabinets are available in different sizes, colors, and styles and may hold baffles and fans to ease cooling and reduce cast-off, and bypass airflow. Therefore <u>CPU cabinet price</u> differs from model to model.

The parts housed inside the case (such as the CPU, memory, motherboard, power supply unit, mass storage devices, and various expansion cards) are known as the internal hardware, while hardware outside the cabinet (usually cable-linked or detachable tools such as the USB flash drives, display, keyboard, speakers, mouse and) are known as peripherals.

A well-made cabinet should offer considerable separation between the cool air supply and hot air return. Cold air is required to simply supply computer cabinets, whilst hot air needs to effortlessly effuse.

## Frame of cabinet

Traditional <u>pc cabinets</u> are fully closed in, with small holes in the back panel that allow airing and cutout openings at back for connecting plugs/sockets and detachable media drive bays (front). The frame of a case is typically made from stiff metals like steel and aluminum alloy. The outside case panels, at least one of which is detachable, wrap the frame from the front, sides, and top to protect the internal components from physical incursion and dust gathering, and are usually made from plastic material or painted metallic. Several modern commercial cabinets are made from other materials such as tempered glass, mesh, acrylic, wood, and

even Lego bricks. Nowadays, open-*air* cases that are only partially enclosed are available in the premium gaming PC market.

## Layout

Cases are sold in various sizes and shapes, which are usually influenced by the form factor of the motherboard since it is physically the biggest hardware constituent in most computers. PC cases typically comprise sheet metal enclosures for a power supply unit and drive bays. Also, there is a rear panel that can house peripheral connectors jutting from the motherboard and expansion slots.

Nearly all cabinets have a power button, a reset button, and LEDs to signify power, hard drive activity and network activity in several models.
