

## The Undergraduate Courses in Canada That Attracts Indian Students

One of the most popular locations in the world for **higher education is Canada**. According to OECD data, Canada spent \$5.9 percent of its GDP and \$11,854 per student on education. These numbers exceed the typical OECD numbers. By the end of 2021, there were about 621,500 foreign students studying in Canada (at all educational levels), with nearly 35 percent of them being Indian.

<u>Universities in Canada</u> provide highly regarded courses that are comparable to degrees from US universities. Canada's education costs are lower than those of other industrialized nations like the US, UK, and Australia.



## An undergraduate diploma in Canada

You should pursue an undergraduate or bachelor's degree after completing your higher secondary education (Class XII). Undergraduate studies typically last three to four years, whereas undergraduate diplomas might last anywhere between six months to a year, depending on the university. A bachelor's degree equates to two-thirds of an honors degree.

## **Canada's Undergraduate Admission Requirements**

Students who meet the standards for a good academic record, ongoing education, an IELTS score, and meeting financial obligations are more likely to be accepted into the university of their choosing.

A minimum of 50% in the 12th grade and an average IELTS score of at least 6 overall bands with no fewer than 5.5 bands in any module are required for admission to UG programmers in Canada. IELTS test results could differ from university to university.

What are the costs associated with these courses?

The cost of UG programmers at SPP Colleges in Canada ranges from CAD 13,000 to 60,000 annually. In general, undergraduate degrees cost between 11,500 and 22,000 Canadian dollars in tuition. Due to the fact that tuition costs vary by university



Highlights of Undergraduate Programs in Canada

The SPP colleges' undergraduate programmers typically last two years, at which time students can apply for open work visas good for three years. After accumulating a minimum of one year of related work experience, students then become able to <u>apply for permanent residency</u> (PR) in Canada.

Additionally, if a student wants to continue their studies for a bachelor's degree program provided by a Canadian university after two years, they can receive credit for previous coursework and finish their bachelor's degree in a minimum of two years.

## **Career Opportunities in India and Abroad**

Typically, courses are provided based on the demand for a particular profession in the nation. A student may work for up to three years on an open work visa depending on their level of education in Canada. They can either obtain the PR or return to India. They will have an advantage over their Indian counterparts after acquiring an international degree, experience, and exposure, and they would find it simple to integrate into multinational corporations.
