


Carrara marble

What do you Think about Carrara Marble?




MATERIALS

Many people are intrigued by the idea of using marble kitchen worktops because it is visually appealing, but its several drawbacks make customers dilemmatic. Because white Carrara marble is a fragile and porous stone, it is prone to staining and requires frequent upkeep. Carrara quartz is an excellent man-made substitute for natural Carrara marble, popularly quarried in Italy. It is manufactured artificially by mixing 93% natural quartz and 7% polymer resins plus color pigments. They are manufactured in such a way that when being used for <u>countertops</u> they do not require sealants or additional treatments. For a busy place like a kitchen that comes in contact with citric acid juices from lemons and various other vegetable

and fruit extracts, knives and forks, heavy appliances etc daily, this becomes a major advantage. The flexible resins make the surface exceptionally resistant to cracking and chipping.

This high-end quartz surface not only looks like real marble but is also devoid of the calciferous stone issues exhibited by it. One quality that makes it better than marble is that it has a non-porous surface that does not absorb moisture. As a result, the surfaces become highly resistant to stains and etch. Another major benefit of this non-porosity is they prevent microorganisms from entering, making them one of the most hygienic options for kitchen worktops.

So, this gorgeous material not just limits itself to a marble-like look with a similar veining pattern on its white surface but also exhibits durability like that of granite.



Highlighting the Advantages

Marble Stones for Kitchen are Heat Resistance



Carrara marble worktops are extremely heat resistant. However, it is common knowledge that hot pans from the stove or oven should never be placed directly upon them. When placing them, it is always recommended to use trivets or heat pads or wait until the pan has cooled slightly.

Marble Countertop are Scratch and Chip Resistance



These <u>white quartzite countertops</u> are highly resistant to scratches and chips. They'll tolerate most scuffs if you're careful not to cut directly on the surface and use a protective tool like a chopping board. Dropped pans or cups will not scratch the surface because they can resist the impacts exceptionally.



Marble Kitchen Countertop are Stain Resistance

Carrara quartz worktops are outstandingly stain-resistant due to their non-porous nature. Small stains are easily identified because of the color and pattern of the surfaces, allowing you to clean them accurately. Stains from red wine, coffee, culinary sauces, and food colorants will not soak into the surface and may easily be wiped away. They're also resistant to citric acid juices like those found in lemon and abrasives like household cleansers.

Hygienic Benefits of White Carrara Marble:



The non-porous nature of Carrara quartz worktops makes them exceptionally hygienic as they do not allow them to absorb spillage. Since the microbes are barred from penetrating the surface, contamination is checked as this makes it difficult for germs to thrive and for mould or rot to develop. Catering organizations and chefs prefer to use Carrara marble white worktops because they give a clean, safe surface for food preparation. Cleaning them is also very simple; all that is required is a moist towel to wipe away the dirt. Spills can be simply cleaned up with a damp cloth and spray. Tougher stains like those arising from cheese, egg spills etc, should be allowed to dry before scraping them off with a plastic knife.

The above-mentioned qualities make this material, low maintenance and are thus high in demand amongst the homeowners.

Carrara Massa Quartz




