If you are planning to serve the communities in Philadelphia in the medical field, **CNA training** is recommended in a reputed training center. After completing a certified nursing course and training, you will become a part of the healthcare team.

Undergoing <u>Nurse Aide training</u> at *PANAT* (Philadelphia Academy for Nurse Aide Training) and obtaining a certification allows you to perform the following duties:

- Giving a bath to patients
- Collecting medical supplies
- Moving or turning the patients
- Attending patient calls
- Checking heart rate, blood pressure, etc,
- Dressing the wounds
- Maintaining documentation
- Cleaning bed linens



Where certified Nursing Assistants can work?

<u>Certified nursing assistants PA</u> find work in healthcare facilities like Adult daycare centers, Nursing homes, hospitals, Clinical facilities, rehabilitation centers, and residential facilities for the long term. The salary for a CNA ranges between \$33,000 and \$40,500 in Philadelphia. You may get a higher salary depending on experience, certifications, education, and additional skills

To undergo *CNA training*, you need to have educational qualifications like GED or high school Diploma. The Department of Health or the board of nursing in the state is responsible for overseeing CNAs. The CNA course fee is \$1,535. You need to contact the training center to know additional details about the training.

What will you learn during Nurse Aide training?

You will be trained by expert faculty in assisting patients with medical challenges. They will teach you with easy-to-understand lectures and demonstrations. You will also be trained in actual nursing techniques and procedures in a healthcare center. On completion of the course and competency certification, you need to apply for certification to become a *certified nursing assistants PA*.

The state center will conduct the competency examination. Upon passing this examination, you need to register with a health registry to become a certified nursing assistant. You need to put in the efforts to move into registered nursing or licensed practical nursing.
