



A Guide for Perfect Rug Placement Around the House

A rug is a wonderful accessory that helps transform the look of the floors of your house. The depth, the warmth and glamor quotient that a rug adds to the interior makes the space look refined and classy.

The choice of rug is a matter of personal taste. But an inappropriate size can be a spoiler and a major barrier for even the most beautiful rug to shine to its full potential. So here are a few tips that can act as a guide to make the right choice for your house.

Always Remember the Basic Standard Rules

Although for rug decoration around the house, the size of the room and the look you want to create in that space, are key factors that govern what size is the best for the area, but still the basic know how of the standard rules with rug placements can really help to make better choices in this regard.

The most common and basic rule of rug placement is that the furniture should be placed in a way that at least the front legs of the furniture pieces like the sofa or chairs should come on the rug. The size of the rug should thus be chosen as per the area of the room and the placement of the furniture.

Still, as it is not always possible to get rugs customized and one might be looking to [buy living room rugs online](#) from the readily available size options, it's important to understand how one can exercise flexibility to use rugs of different sizes. Designing as a field has a lot of scope for creative independence which must be explored as and when required.



Ideas For Living Room Rug Placement

For the living room as the look and feel desired is casual and relaxed, one can opt for two alternate looks besides the standard look achieved by applying the above rule. The first look is when the rug being used is in a bold pattern and colour, and the idea is to use it in the area just as a pop up.

So here, when the aim is to use it for beauty and not functionality, a setting with a rug size that covers the centre area of the space with just the centre table on the rug and the rest of the furniture surrounding the rug can work well.

The second look can be used if the living space is open and has another adjoining setting, like the dining or double seating space in the same area. In either case, it is recommended to go for a larger rug size that is able to accommodate the furniture fully on the rug.

This means that all four legs of the sofa or chair should be placed on the rug so that the area looks well segregated from the rest of the space. The rug will act like the perfect landing for all the furniture set near to it and makes the area look neater and well-defined.

Bedroom Rug Sizes to Opt For

The best way to style a rug in the bedroom is to make sure to get a size that is big enough for it to be tucked under the bed with its sides extending out. So, while looking for [floor rugs online](#) make sure that the size is such that $\frac{3}{4}$ th of the rug can go under the bed and at least 12-18 inches of the rug extends from the sides around the bed.

This setting is perfect to create a plush and warm feel for any bedroom space. In case of a smaller sized rug, one can place it effectively at the foot of the bed.

Hallway Passages and Entryways

Having a rug in the entry or hallway is a beautiful and pleasing way of decorating the entrance of the house and the passages around the place. While placing a rug here one should opt for a size which is able to cover the majority of the walking area. This makes it comfortable to walk on the rug and provides an even landing for the feet while walking.
