

Sealing your black pearl stone:




A sealant will be applied to the surface of the Black Pearl UK to prevent liquids from readily absorbing. As natural granite is porous, sealants are used to protect the stone. Sealing the surface is the first step in keeping it in good condition. It helps to periodically test Black Pearl Granite for leaks to see whether it needs to be resealed. If the slab readily absorbs the water, it must be sealed every six to twelve months. Put a couple of ounces of water on the surface to see if it's "thirsty."

Cleaning Your Black Pearl Granite Worktop Surface:




In addition to cleaning Black Pearl on a daily basis, and especially if your sealer has worn down or dissolved, you may find that you need to remove a stain of some kind. When this happens, you will require a different type of cleaner. There are a variety of speciality cleaners

available that are designed to remove specific types of discolorations. These cleaners are also known as stain removers. Depending on the type of stain or discoloration, you will require a remover designed for that substance.



Maintaining Your Black Pearl countertop:



It really comes down to developing a regular cleaning and sealing routine for your natural Black Pearl Granite surface. Once you've got the routine down, it'll be second nature.

- Clean any debris from the surface with a pH-neutral cleaner to keep the sealer from breaking down.
- When your granite surface becomes "thirsty"*, reseal it.
- Using a heavily protected stone polish on a regular basis gradually maintains the sealer on the natural stone's surface.
