When dark countertops are balanced with light cabinetry and walls, they become the focal point of any home. Quartz countertops are one-of-a-kind and can elevate the look of your home. Although dark countertops can appear intimidating, combining them with light-coloured walls and cabinets helps to balance out the darker palette. Dark Quartz Designs:

The Soft Contrast



To create depth and interest, the light wood floor, white cabinetry, and warm-toned backsplash tile need to be broken up. That's where this dark grey countertop shines. It has a slightly warm undertone that enhances the warmth already present in the room, but it is darker than the other shades, providing contrast and depth.

New Contemporary Design



Smooth, sleek surfaces and clean lines are the key features of modern kitchens. Many spaces require some contrast between lights and darks to help highlight these angles. This dark quartz countertop contrasts nicely with the light wood cabinetry, but it also has some interest and movement of its own. This keeps the kitchen from looking sterile and adds some interest and design to it.

Darkness and Lightness

To create depth, many light and dark tones are combined in transitional and traditional kitchens. The island in this case is the darkest colour in the room, creating a focal point. The quartz countertop connects the darkest tones of the island to the lighter colours of the perimeter cabinets. This creates a unified appearance that helps to tie everything together.

Surfaces that Match



The cabinets in this light and dark kitchen are light on top and dark on the bottom. The quartz countertop matches the colour of the lower cabinetry, creating a one-of-a-kind look. Only the surface texture varies, allowing light to hit the counter differently than it does the cabinets. By changing the surface planes but keeping the colours the same, you can make a smaller space appear larger than it is.

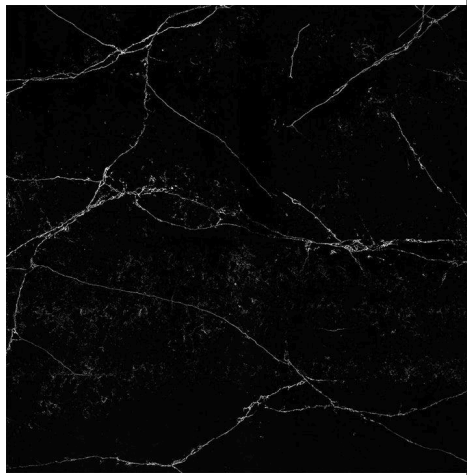
Focus on the Dark

Traditional and transitional designs can still use contrast to add depth and interest to a space. This kitchen accomplishes this by making dark colours the focal points of the design. On the island, perimeter counters, and seating area, dark woodwork and cabinetry are paired with rich, dark quartz countertops. The light tones serve as accents in the space, keeping it from becoming too dark.

Ocean Quartz:



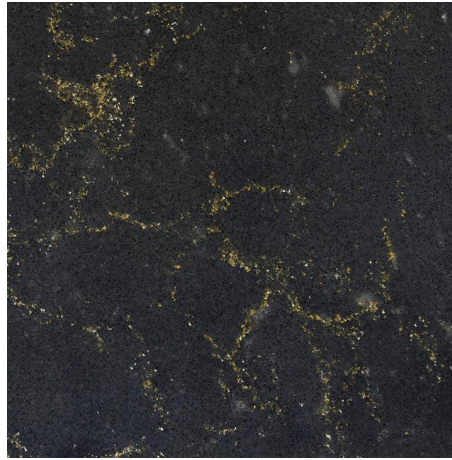

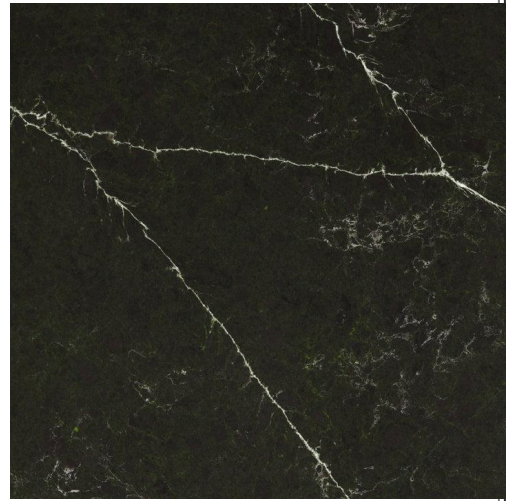
