

Good pitching like a welcome rain in a difficult situation for the team

It was like a welcome rain in a difficult situation for the team.

SSG Landers won 5-1 against the LG Twins in the 2024 Shinhan SOL Bank KBO League at Jamsil Stadium in Seoul on the 21st.

Starting pitcher Roenis Elias' good pitching shone. He started the game with a hit by leadoff hitter Hong Chang-ki in the bottom of the first inning. With Shin Min-jae's bases loaded with one out, he caught Austin Dean with a fly ball to the first baseman. He allowed Moon Bo-kyung to walk to continue the crisis, but induced Park Dong-won to hit a ground ball to the third baseman to post the final out count.

He allowed a walk to Park Hae-min in the second inning, but passed the walk without much crisis. In the bottom of the third inning, he allowed leadoff hitter Hong Chang-ki to walk. Hong was in danger of scoring due to his stolen base with two outs, but he grounded out to second base to Moon Bo-kyung. In the fourth inning, he struck out a crisis with two outs and runners on the second base.

Elias, who completed the first three-and-out inning of the game in the bottom of the fifth inning, came down from the mound after stopping the sixth and seventh innings without losing a point. He played a scoreless game in about five months after pitching a scoreless pitch against the Lotte Giants in Incheon on March 24.

After that, Noh Kyung-eun scored one run in one inning, but Cho Byung-hyun finished the game by blocking the ninth inning without a run. 메이저사이트

Guillermo Herredia took the lead in the bottom of the first inning. Then, pinch hitter Kim Sunghyun made a timely hit with an RBI single in the top of the seventh inning to run away. Then, he sealed the lead in the top of the ninth inning. With the team leading 2-1, Oh Tae-gon hit a two-run homer. Then, he made a chance with Lee Ji-young's hit and a walk to the Jihoon Choi, and Choo Shin-soo's timely RBI single made a four-run gap.

After losing four games in a row, SSG succeeded in maintaining its fifth position. We were able to break the losing streak thanks to stellar pitching by starting pitchers Elias and field veterans including (Chu) Shin-soo, (Kim) Sung-hyun, and (Oh) Tae-gon, SSG coach Lee Soo-yong said after the game. By far, Elias contributed the most to today's victory. Elias pitched seven innings without allowing a single goal. His performance was as good as a welcome rain at a time when the team was in a difficult situation.

On the fielder's side, Taegon hit a decisive two-run homer in the top of the ninth inning when the gap was one point behind Sung-hyun's RBI single. With Shin-soo's RBI single, we were able to secure victory, he continued. The players did a great job despite the hot weather. We will prepare well for tomorrow's game.
