Argentina vs France match, final results of the 2022 Qatar World Cup Argentina won the 2022 World Cup After a thrilling 3-3 in 120 minutes, <u>Argentina</u> beat France 4-2 on penalties to win their third World Cup, after 36 years. And earlier, while Argentina took a 2-0 lead through <u>Lionel Messi</u> and Angel Di Maria, Kylian Mbappe held France apart with two goals in the space of 97 seconds in the second half. France coach Didier Deschamps is back in the preferred squad after center-backs Dayot Upamecano and Adrien Rabiot survived the virus that kept them out of the semi-final against Morocco. Upamecano starts alongside Raphael Varane after the Manchester United defender also recovered from a virus, while Olivier Giroud starts the attack with Kylian Mbappe on his left and Ousmane Dembele on his right.

The final ever World Cup handed the title to footballing icon, Lionel Messi, on Sunday when Argentina defeated men's champions France on penalties.

In one of the most exciting major sporting events in history, the two teams tied 3-3 after extra time, and the French eventually missed twice on penalties before Gonzalo Montiel converted an exhausting and emotional victory.

Argentina dominated most of the match

Argentina dominated most of the game, leading 2-0 with about 10 minutes left, but France suddenly exploded with star striker Kylian Mbappe scoring twice in as many minutes. The two teams exchanged missed opportunities and late goals again in 30 minutes of extra time before the penalty kicks spoiled.



The game capped a month of sports drama and geopolitical controversy in Qatar. The tournament featured surprising results and fantasy runs, but the final match saw two of the game's giants battle it out for the title - headed by a pair of superstars.

Mbappe cemented his claim as a young defender of Messi's throne, with the quick and skillful striker scoring a hat-trick as France came close to being the first team to back up since Brazil in 1962.

But in the end, it was Messi who took the glory, securing the trophy that cemented his place as perhaps the most excellent game of all time, as the 35-year-old catapulted onto the world stage by winning the third title for his football-mad country.
