With me planning to make my second contribution to this series of Scratch AYs started all the way back in 2017, and getting annual releases up until 2020 (there was no installment for 2021), it's finally time for me to write down the list of emotions I plan to add into **Scratcher Emotions 5!** It'll be the most modern installment of the series yet, with a similar UI to the [previous installment](#), but featuring heavily refined graphics, more efficient coding, a modernized music system with audio-exemption lists in their latest form, and overall many upgrades to the style to make this the most modern installment yet.

But, of course, we shouldn't forget the NEW list of emotions for this installment! Featuring not just new emotions, but changes & refinements to old feels from across the series!

EMOTION CATEGORIES:

Yellow - JOY - 14 emotions in this category

Blue - GLOOM - 7 emotions in this category

Red - FURY - 11 emotions in this category

Purple - FEAR - 9 emotions in this category

Green - THOUGHT - 5 emotions in this category

Pink - CONDITION - 16 emotions in this category

Grey - OTHER - 6 emotions in this category

The BOREDOM category from the original could return with a rename...

Emotion categories must contain at least 3 emotions, or else they are just classified as 'OTHER'.

For this list, an idea of what all expressions should look like will be alluded to by an emoji. However, me & a lot of other users are still using Windows 10, which appears to no longer to getting it's emoji set updated (thanks to Windows 11's release), meaning that for me, some of these emojis may be

unsupported, and replaced by rectangular boxes similar to this one:



Therefore, this time around I'll be paying more attention to making this project compatible with all devices by figuring out how to get around this issue with the 'Emoji' character. This character may no

longer be able to just be the emojis typed into a textbox - instead, it may have to feature pictures of the emojis from a specific emoji set... Any ideas for which set I should use specifically?...

And so, with all this rambling out of the way, it's finally time to see that list...

ALL 68 EMOTIONS

Emotions with names in **bold** are new to Scratcher Emotions 5. For emotions with names in *italics* I'm not sure if they will be included or not. Text in *{curly brackets}* won't be featured in the final project, and are just notes.

😊 **Glad (Slightly happy)** *{emoji originally used for 'Happy'}*

😄 Happy *{emoji originally used for 'Very happy'}*

😁 Very happy *{emoji originally used for 'Excited'}*

😍 Joyful/Carefree

😄 **Delighted! (Extremely happy / Very joyful/carefree)**

😄 Excited

😮 Surprised/Amazed

😏 Smug

😊/😳/😬 Bashful/Coy (Blushing + Happy)

😍 Starry-eyed

😍 Hearty-eyed

😄 **Giggling (Quietly laughing)**

😄 Laughing (Loudly giggling)

😞 Down *{originally named 'Sad'}*

😞 Sad *{originally named 'Very sad'}* *{This emoji displays as a Unicode-styled character on my PC, but as a regular emoji on my laptop - must be to do with font difference}*

😞 Despaired/Miserable (Extremely sad) *{originally named 'Depressed', but changed to avoid stigmatization with actual depression}*

😭 Teary-eyed (Softly crying)

😡 Annoyed

😡 Upset (Very annoyed)

😡 Frustrated *{emoji originally used for 'Upset'}*

 **Greedy-eyed** {could be recategorized in the final release, but I put it here due to greed being a negative trait}

 Stunned {originally named 'Astonished', but changed to make it more clear this is supposed to be a more neutral equivalent to 'Surprised' and 'Shocked' - t'was also originally categorized in 'Other', but this could be recategorized AGAIN in future...}

 **Humiliated (Very embarrassed - Blushing + Despaired/Miserable)** {may be recategorized to GLOOM in the final release}

 /  /  /   **Scheming (Thinking + Mischievous)** {the monocled emoji was chosen as one of the options due to this high-class item feeling somewhat like a 'villianous' accessory}

 Bored {originally categorized in 'Boredom'}



 Exhausted {emoji originally used for 'Frustrated'}

 Tired (Very bored/exhausted) {originally categorized in 'Boredom'}

 **Sleepy (Very tired / Extremely bored/exhausted)**

  Sleeping (Very sleepy/Extremely tired/Extroadinarily bored/exhausted)



  **Dreaming (Sleeping + Happy)** {What the character is dreaming of could be shown in a thought bubble}

  **Nightmare (Sleeping + Upset/Scared)** {What the character is having a nightmare about could be shown in a thought bubble}

 Hungry {The food that the character is craving could be shown in a thought bubble}

 **Savouring food** {The character could be holding the food they're eating in their floating hands}

 Disgusted

 /  **Sickened** (Extremely disgusted) {I know that the vomiting face may be a bit extreme, but the emoji set doesn't offer any other that don't just show an actual illness - some other characters may be holding back the urge to gag}

 Dizzy (Extremely confused/puzzled / Very disgusted)

 **Knocked out/Unconcious** {I know that some devices may still display this with spiral eyes like the 'Dizzy' emoji, instead of X-eyes.}

 Bandaged

 Overheated

 Freezing

👁️ **X-Ray**

😄 Funny face!

😎 Coolio {originally categorized in 'Joy'}

🟡 **Blank** {the character's eyes & mouth are missing, but the rest of their now-featureless face remains - the outlines can be removed for extra minimalistic style}

👤/❌ **Missing/Away** {The outline of the character's head remains, but their actual head is now gone, and may even be crossed out}

And that's it! All 68 emotions, of which 23 are new. (most of the new emotions were ones introduced for the new 'Condition' category) This is gonna be a real time-consuming AY to remix, I know.... Maybe y'all should consider making your characters before you add them in a remix?

OTHER RANDOM NOTES BECAUSE WHY NOT

1. I've been planning to write down this list for the emotions that Scratcher Emotions 5 would feature for a long while now, but every time I've gotten the chance beforehand, I put it off until it was too late. At least I got a LOT of time to sort out this list's structure in my head.
2. For the initial release, I plan to have Paul, Erny, and the Emoticon to return from the 4th installment, as well as having Walburt & Ripley appear as newcomers...
 - As an idea for a character that could appear in a future remix... How about 'Advanced Emoticon'? This character's presence could rename the existing emoticon character to 'Basic Emoticon', as they would use symbols from Unicode & foreign languages (particularly East-Asian typography) to make much more complex & stylized expressions than what can usually be achieved on a QWERTY keyboard!
 - Depending on how the 'Emoji' character is added this time around, variations of it could appear using different emoji sets than the initial release's.
3. If you've ever wondered why searching for the Scratcher Emotions series only seems to bring up the first & fourth installments... then it's because, on the second & third installments, the series was actually known as 'Scratchers Emotions', with an S on the end of 'Scratcher' (the first installment started this way too, but lost the S somewhere on the remix chain). Another similarly-named series with a discrepancy like this I know of is 'Scratch's Doors'.
