



How to Change Gmail Password in Your Personal Accounts

Learn Step by Step that how to change your Gmail account Password:

1. From the Gmail email inbox, choose Settings (gear icon).
2. Select All options.
3. Choose from the Accounts tab and the Import tab.
4. In the Change settings for your account Next to the Change account settings section, click Change password.
5. Login with your existing password in order to verify your identity. Then, select Next.
6. Input and the new password. Then, click Change Password.

What happens when you change your password?

If you modify the password or change it You'll be locked out everywhere else, excluding:
Devices that you use to confirm that you're your account when you log in. Certain devices have third-party applications that you've granted access to your account. Learn how to disable access granted by an app on your account. The devices you use for home assistance that you've given account access to.

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
