# Fabric/Upholstered Seating Care



Vacuum at least once a week giving particular attention to the removal of dust between the fabric.



Spillages should be cleaned with a soft damp cloth as soon as possible to avoid moisture damage.

Oils and minor spills should be quickly blotted out with an absorbent paper towel or clean cloth to avoid staining.



Several light applications of cleaning solution are more effective and less damaging than one heavy application.

If the stain has dried, first brush any excess off, then vacuum the stain, then clean using soapy water, rinse with clean water afterwards.



Never use furniture polishes, oils and varnishes, as it may cause discoloration and should be tested in an inconspicuous area before using.

When cleaning stains with liquid solutions, avoid over-saturation. Over-saturation distributes the stain deeper into the fiber.



Avoid sitting on the furniture with a sweaty or dusty body to prolong

the life of the furniture.

Sharp objects can cause snagging, tearing or pulling of the fabric.



Cut any loose threads off the upholstered seating, do not pull them.

Pets and upholstered furniture do not mix.



Avoid exposure to direct sunlight to prevent bleaching or discoloration.

For tough spots and spills, professional upholstery cleaning is recommended.
