- 2) Personal Statement - This section asks you to describe why you want to study at this university and how it will help with your career goals. It also requires you to provide references from people who know about your academic abilities or work experience (this can be teachers). - 3) Essay Questions - These questions are common across all MBA programs worldwide, but they may vary in format depending on which school you're applying for.*
