


Exquisite Handcrafted Aari Embroidery Fabric for Elegant Designs

Aari work is a type of <u>embroidery</u> which is done on a stretched fabric and stitching the design with a long needle which has a hook in the end. Aari work is known for its elegant thread work that enhances the gravity of hand embroidery. Aari work is considered appropriate for all seasons as it can be done on velvet, silk, cotton, cotton silk, chanderi, and many other fabrics



Embroidery refers to the thread craft that enhances the look of a fabric or product. This thread craft is generally done on natural fabrics with tight weaves. Embroidery designs of India are

influenced by different cultures and have a flavor of their own. Indian embroidery is cherished by craftsmen and has the world swooning over them. Embroidery designs are formed on the basis of texture of the fabric.



It may also include decorating materials other than threads, like pearls, beads, stones and sequins. India is known for its beautiful embroidery techniques. Fundamental stitches of embroidery are running stitch, cross stitch and satin stitch. Surface embroidery techniques are more economical. Aari embroidery is one of the many forms of embroidery, originated in the Mughal era. Aari work is a type of embroidery work that is done by stretching the fabric tightly over a wooden frame. A pen-like needle, that resembles a crochet needle is used to do the intrinsic Aari work.

Indian Women Wedding Aari Lehenga :

Aari work embroidery is popularly found in wedding lehengas and formal Indian lehengas. Aari work lehengas have a rich look and feel. You could buy cotton jacquard lehenga or silk brocade lehenga, embossed with bead work, in order to attain the majestic look.



Aari work lehenga requires intricate detailing, hence designers use advanced technology to fit in these embellishments in bridal clothing. It's done using new stitching techniques for weaving such as backstitching, cross stitching, single stitching and coughing. Couching stitch is done by binding together beads on the fabric. Interesting styles such as chikankari embroidery or stone work embroidery can be teamed with bead work to create a splendorous effect.



A variety of fabrics — cotton, velvet, chiffon or faux georgette — are being used to design aari work embroidery lehengas. Crystals, gemstones and pearls can be used as adornments on
