



What are the Important Details of a CPA Course?

To clarify, a candidate with a B.Com or any other equivalent degree in commerce background is eligible to take up the exam. Provided, the college/university is NAAC accredited. (crediting 120 semester credits to the candidate). If the candidate has completed the masters, he is credited with an extra 60 semester credits, a total of 150 credits, which is the perfect number to earn the CPA license. However, a bachelor's degree alone does not qualify for the exam as the required credits to attempt a CPA exam is 120.

[CPA Exam consists majorly of 3 sections](#) (4-hours each), Financial Accounting & Reporting (FAR), Auditing & Attestation (AUD), Taxation & Regulation (REG). For the 4th section, a candidate is allowed to choose between Business Analysis & Reporting (BAR), Information Systems & Controls (ISC) and Tax Compliances & Planning (TCP).
