

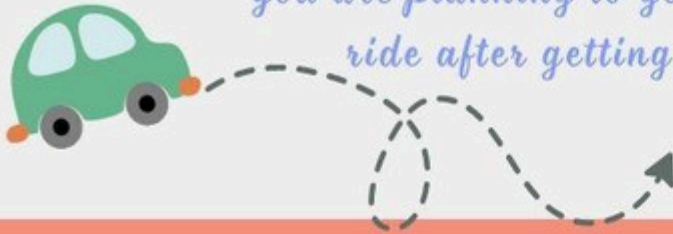


Tips For Your First Ride As A New Driver

Below are some of the tips you can follow if you are planning to go on your first solo ride after getting your license.



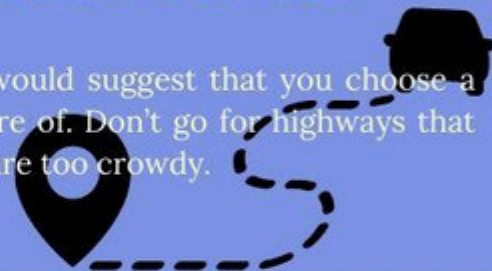
Familiarize yourself with your car

Take some time to know the position of the brakes, accelerator, and clutch (if driving manual). Adjust the seat accordingly so that you have a clear view of your front line.



Plan your route beforehand

For your first solo drive, I would suggest that you choose a route that you are well aware of. Don't go for highways that are risky or busy areas that are too crowded.



Have a health check-up of your car

Before heading out check the oil and other fluids, inspect the tires for proper inflation, and ensure that all the lights are working.





Be prepared for emergencies

Make sure you are carrying your phone, emergency supplies like an extra tire, and a first aid kit. If you do experience a breakdown, then try to pull over at a safe place and call for help.



Stay calm

It is easy to get anxious when driving solo for the first time. Without an instructor beside you, you can become nervous and confused. But remember that you can always pull over and take time to collect yourself.
