

The Ultimate Guide For CDR Writing in 2022



Preparing your own <u>Competency Demonstration Report (CDR)</u> can lead to a higher chance of lacking necessary information or structuring it poorly, especially if you do not have the experience or knowledge required to follow the guidelines. Therefore, it is advisable to gain good knowledge of how to prepare a high-quality CDR report.

The CDR is crucial to the <u>Australian Skilled Migration</u> Application, and it is essential to avoid mistakes while preparing it. <u>CDR Writers</u> has a team of experienced and professional experts who have been positively assessed by EA and have many years of experience as engineers. <u>When writing a CDR report</u>, it is important to follow these major points:

- Choose the engineering occupation that you want to apply for in the Migration Skill
 Assessment process, based on your academic qualifications, skills, knowledge, and
 experience.
- 2. Learn everything about the Migration Skill Assessment Process and have a better idea of the Competency Demonstration Report.
- 3. Follow all the guidelines and instructions listed in the MSA booklet set by Engineers Australia.
- 4. Categorize the project that you want to illustrate in your career episode report, highlighting your competencies and knowledge in a detailed format for your CDR report.
- 5. Prepare each of your three career episodes with at least 1000-2500 words using prescriptive writing style with marking as per the guideline listed in the <u>Migration Skill Assessment booklet</u>. Your career episode should demonstrate the roles and responsibilities that you performed during that project.

- 6. Prepare a summary statement report that represents the summary of your career episode report.
- 7. Avoid using complicated technical terms, unnecessary figures, and charts, etc. Only mention the details that highlight your skills and experience.
- 8. Mention your progress and the problems that arose during the project, including the solutions to those problems.
- 9. Highlight your leadership skills and interpersonal relations with other members to impress your EA assessor.
- 10. Use <u>Continuing Professional Development (CPD)</u> report to highlight more detail about your work.
- 11. Take many CDR samples available online as a reference, but do not use the same content. Mention original content in the CDR report.

For further guidance on preparing your CDR report, refer to the guidelines provided by Engineers Australia on <u>career episodes</u>, <u>summary statement</u>, and Continuing Professional Development (CPD).

When submitting your CDR report to Engineers Australia assessors, ensure that you include the necessary documents, such as passport size photo, passport, educational degree with a certificate, educational transcript, updated resume, and evidence of the experience gained mentioned in the CDR report and career episode reports.
