



Jeong Kwan-jang lost to Fubon once again, but his performance changed

Jeong Kwan-jang's performance is getting better.

Anyang Jeong Kwan-jang had a practice match with the Fubon Braves under Taiwan's P.LEAGUE+ at the National Taiwan University of the Arts in Taipei, Taiwan on Tuesday. The team never won a match against the Fubon Braves. The result is 66-79.

Before their second showdown with Fubon, Jeong Kwan-jang's coach Kim Sang-sik said, "On the 21st, Fubon asked us to use two foreign players. That's how we can practice." Today, however, is different. We have to use one foreign player, so we have to practice that situation," adding, "We did not receive one foreign player."

"Of course, the opponents use three foreign players, including naturalized players.

Realistically, it's hard for us to deal with. However, if you think about it the other way around, we're dealing with a good physical player. It will be helpful," he said, adding the meaning of the practice match on Tuesday.

However, Jeong Kwan-jang was hit with bad news. Choi Sung-won (184 cm, G), a ball handler, injured his right ankle on the 21st. It was a minor injury, but Jeong Kwan-jang manager Kim Sang-sik said, "I will give Choi a break." For that reason, Park Ji-hoon (184 cm, G) and Lee Won-dae (182 cm, G) had to take charge of the practice match on the 22nd.

Park Ji-hoon and Bae Byung-joon (189 centimeters, G), Harvey Gomez (195 centimeters, F), Jonghyun Lee (203 centimeters, C), and Caddy Lahren (204 centimeters, C) were included in the starting lineup. They also faced off against Fubon, which deployed three foreign players (including those from Taiwan University).

However, Jeong did not lose ground in the height fight. Rather, he noticed Fubon's strategy of utilizing the base of the goal. On the other hand, he created space by utilizing the large space. In just four minutes and 48 seconds after the start of the game, he took the lead with 8-6.

After that, Jeong Kwan-jang fought against Fubon. Considering the inferiority of the available foreign players, Jeong Kwan-jang's performance was not bad. Rather, he showed good performance with clever predictive defense and quick attack. Although he was upset 16-17, his performance was not bad.

Lee Won-dae (182cm, G), Jung Joon-won (194cm, F), Jung Hyo-geun (200cm, F), and Michael Young (206cm, F) were the first to play in the second quarter. Among the starting lineup, only Bae Byung-joon was included in the second quarter. Since Lauren and Jonghyun Lee were absent, the height fight of the casket became more important.

Jeong Hyo-geun and Young took the lead, and Jeong's defensive energy level was no different from that of the first quarter. Jeong led 22-21 just 2:02 into the second quarter.

However, Jung Joon-won and Jung Hyo-geun had to block the opposing foreign player. The foreign player Jung Joon-won and Jung Hyo-geun faced off was also the forward type, but the two players tried to relieve Young's physical burden.

However, as Fubon put Jeff Withery (213 cm, C) back in, the articles of incorporation were slightly lost to the different colors of Fubon. In addition, there were more pass misses.

Because of this, the articles of incorporation could not maintain the lead for long. It fell to 22-25 just 3:50 into the second quarter.

Jung Joon-won scored three points in a row, and Jeong's tall players, including Jeong Hyo-geun, defended well against Fubon's offensives. He led 32-27 at one point in the second quarter.

However, Jeong did not maintain his upward momentum for long. He could not overcome the mismatch between a forward and a foreign player from Fubon, and he was shaken by Fubon's quick attack. The shaken Chung finished the first half 37-42.

Park Ji-hoon, Bae Byeong-joon, Gomez, Jonghyun Lee, and Lahren came out again in the third quarter. The five players had stable position balance, and Jeong Kwan-jang chased Fubon 41-42 just 1:10 into the third quarter.

However, the articles of association did not exceed one point. Also, he failed to target Fubon's modified area defense well. He finished the third quarter 51-60.

Lee Won-dae and Song Chang-yong (191 cm, F), Jung Joon-won, Jung Hyo-geun, and Young came out in the fourth quarter. The combination that came out in the second quarter turned out the same. They countered with a quick turnaround of offense and defense. Although they were pushed 57-65 with 8:22 left before the end of the game, they led Fubon to a timeout with easy fastballs. However, the players are getting more and more tired. Manager Kim Sang-sik also knew this. However, he said to those who are not good at box-outs, "Shouldn't we start from the basics?" He sent a message to the players in a strong tone.

However, the main forwards in the fourth quarter got tired, and Jeong Kwan-jang manager Kim Sang-sik substituted Kim Joon-hyung (201cm, F) and Kim Kyung-won (198cm, C). Kim put more effort into defense, while Kim contributed to the team by making quick attacks. Jeong also maintained a one-digit score gap with 64-73 five minutes before the end of the game. Jeong did quite well afterwards. Considering the composition of his members, Jeong's final performance was not bad. Although he also lost his second practice match against Fubon, he showed better performance than his practice match on the 21st. It was better than putting in two foreign players. Jeong's coaching staff and officials also said, "I think I'm getting better."
