About Narayangaon

Narayangaon is a town situated on the western edge of the Deccan plateau at an altitude of 656 m. The town can be easily accessed by road from major cities and is located on the banks of the Meena river. With a wide hill range separating it from the adjoining Ambegaon taluka to the south, the town offers a glimpse into medieval architecture, with nearby caves, dams, and other popular tourist attractions. Narayangaon has also been featured in films and commercials. Manikdoh, a leopard rehabilitation center located 25 km west of Narayangaon, and Malshej Ghat, a popular tourist attraction that can be reached within a 45-minute drive, are some of the places worth visiting. Shivneri Fort, located 16 km west of Narayangaon, is the birthplace of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj. The name Narayangaon is believed to have originated from the nearby Narayangad fort, which is located 8 km northeast of the town.

For nature lovers and trekking enthusiasts, nearby hill ranges such as Ganpirbaba, Chawnd, Nimgiri, Dhakoba, Hadsar, Jivdhan, and Harishchandra are a must-visit. These areas are also home to rare plant species. The Muktabai Temple, located on the Meena river bank, is a prominent religious site in Narayangaon. The town also boasts other temples, such as the Lord Ram temple, Hanuman temple, and Shambhu Mahadev temple, a branch of the Shikhar Shingnapur Mahadev temple.

Tourists can also visit nearby religious sites such as the Ashtavinayak Ganapati temples - Shri Girijatmaka of Lenyadri and Vigneshwara Temple in Ozar. The Kapardikeshwar Lord Shiva temple in Otur and the Lord Khandoba temple near Wadaj are other popular religious sites that can be visited. The Muktaai yatra, which starts after the day of Varuthini Ekadashi, is one of the biggest festivals in Maharashtra and attracts visitors from all over the state.
