What is a divorce certificate?

A Divorce certificate is a document issued by the court that provides evidence that a marriage has been terminated. A divorce certificate is needed for people who have been divorced, widowed or whose spouse has died. Divorced spouses must provide their ex-spouse's death or divorce certificate and their birth certificates when applying for a new passport. The issuing state should certify the divorce certificate, which should come with an official seal and signature from a public notary. The issuing state's consulate can also issue the documents if they are resident in Abu Dhabi. If you live outside of Abu Dhabi but your wedding took place here, you'll need to go through your home country's consulate, which will process your divorce

documentation on your behalf and forward it to us so we can make a copy before returning it to them.

Why do you need to get a divorce certificate translated?

A divorce certificate is a document that proves that a court has terminated the marriage. If you are going to marry someone else, your future spouse will want to know that your previous marriage has ended legally. Some countries require a translation of the divorce certificate when you get remarried, but this varies from country to country. Sometimes, it's necessary because they won't recognize the original document. The requirements also depend on whether or not both parties have agreed to the termination of the marriage and how it was concluded (e.g., through separation or annulment).

The process of divorce certificate translation in Abu Dhabi

It is a legal requirement for a divorce certificate to be translated into Arabic. This translation needs to be done by a certified translator authorized by the Emirate of Abu Dhabi and can provide you with an apostille. The translator must certify that the documents are true and accurate.

The cost of this service will vary depending on where you are located and how quickly you need the translation.
