

Repeat the procedure as necessary, followed by a thorough rinsing with water and drying of the afflicted region.

Avoiding direct contact with liquids as much as you can is the best way to keep your quartz worktops stain-free. Avoid using your worktop as a cutting board, keep it free of anything very acidic, and try to keep the area surrounding your sink as dry as you can.



Actually, quartz is a very hygienic substance. Because it is so compact and dense, bacteria cannot grow or spread as easily as they might on other materials. This makes cleaning quick and simple.

Warm water and a non-abrasive cleaner or neutral soap are what we advise using to clean your quartz countertops every day. 
Substantial Aesthetic


