It has served as a mediator in international conflicts. By contrast, Romania experienced communist rule until 1989 and the fall of Nicolae Ceausescu's dictatorship. It has ambitions to someday join the Schengen area and adopt the euro currency like Switzerland, which has steadfastly maintained its independence from the European Union. Economically, Switzerland has consistently ranked as one of the most competitive and innovative economies in the world. Its GDP per capita is over five times higher than Romania's.
