Canada's Express Entry system operates through periodic draws. In these draws, candidates in the Express Entry pool are issued Invitations to Apply (ITAs) for permanent residence. The

draws are typically held every few weeks, and the number of ITAs and the minimum Comprehensive Ranking System (CRS) score required can vary from draw to draw.

The Canadian government conducts an express entry draw approximately every two weeks, and the latest draw for express entry, 271, was held on October 26th and Now October 26th 20.23.
