Feed For Baby Chicks

Alfalfa meal

They begin by drying out adult plants (*Medicago sativa*), then grind them into a fine powder. If it's going to be used as animal feed, it's fermented first to make it more palatable to ruminant livestock.



Corn

chickens can eat cornmeal. Cornmeal is basically dried ground corn. Most chickens eat corn, grains, and cereal grains as they are included in most commercial feeds.

Field peas

Chickens can eat peas; they are safe to eat either cooked, raw, or frozen. ... One important note to consider is that dried peas are not great for your birds.
