WATERPROOF YOUR FOUNDATION

The best way to waterproof your foundation is to install a rain screen that drains water away from the main drainage system.



REPAIR CRACKS AND HOLES

Regular inspection of your foundation for holes and cracks proves to be vital for preventing



damage.

FIX WALL CRACKS AND GAPS

Another issue that causes rainwater to drain down to the foundation is a crack in an exterior wall. Which must be repaired immediately.
