"40-40" in a season with his 27th stolen base

Superstar Shohei Ohtani of the Los Angeles Dodgers has achieved the highest number of stolen bases in a single season. He can join the club with 40 home runs and 40 steals.

Ohtani started the away game against Houston in the 2024 Major League Baseball at Minute Maid Park in Houston, Texas on Tuesday local time, and had no hits in four at-bats for two strikeouts. He had multiple hits in three consecutive games, but his feet were strong.

Ohtani, who had two strikeouts and two flies in his previous four at-bats, walked as a leadoff hitter in the top of the ninth inning with a 5-2 lead. He immediately ran to steal the base on second base. Ohtani, who entered second base by sliding, recorded his 27th stolen base of the season.

Ohtani broke his record in 2021 and posted the most stolen bases in a season. Ohtani settled on third base on a subsequent bases-loaded walk by Teoscar Hernandez and scored on Jason Heyward's sacrifice fly. <u>토토사이트 순위</u>

Ohtani has 32 homers and 27 steals for this season, increasing his chances of 40-40 games. With the current pace, he can record 48 homers and 40 steals. He is one step closer to achieving the record of 40-40 games for the sixth time in the Major League history.

LA Dodgers manager Dave Roberts said after the game that Ohtani, who is active in various areas of offense, said, "It is a great pleasure to see him study baseball." The Dodgers won the game 6-2, leading the National League West.
