## Life Cycle Of A Bed Bug

- Bed bugs usually go through six stages in their lives and entirely depend on blood to move from one stage to another.
- A bedbug requires at least one meal of blood to enter another stage, and sometimes they require more than one meal.
- Once they enter the next stage, they shed their skin that can be used as evidence while doing an inspection.
- The life span of a healthy female bedbug is generally about 6 months to a year or more. A female can lay somewhere between one and five eggs per day and can produce 200-500 eggs during their entire lifespan.

- Both male and female bedbugs need at least one meal of blood in two weeks to continue breeding and producing their offsprings.

## What Are the Alarming Signs?

- Bedbugs are extremely tiny bugs, and it is often challenging to suspect them through the naked eye. An inspection through the naked eye is rarely effective unless it's performed by a **professional bed bug exterminator in Phoenix**. However, few tricks will help you detect a bedbug infestation in your home.
- If you find dark brown clumps that can easily spread when you clean them with the help of a wet cloth. These dark brown droppings are the fecal discharge of bed bugs.
- When you spot reddish or rust-colored stains on your rugs, mattresses, cushions, etc. These reddish stains appear when you crush a bed bug mistakenly, especially if it was going to bite you or done with the biting.
- The appearance of tiny eggs or eggshells in your bed, sofa, the carpet could be a possible sign of a bedbug infestation. These eggshells are usually shed by bedbug nymphs while they're moving from one stage to another stage.
- If you notice a live brown wingless, oval-shaped bug in your house, just capture it. If you think what you find looks like a bed bug, you could show it to a professional bed bug exterminator for verification. We suggest reaching out to a professional bed bug exterminator for help.
