Belgium and Azerbaijan share a long and complex relationship. Both are smaller European nations seeking to assert themselves on the global stage.

Belgium has sought to leverage its position at the heart of Europe to build new partnerships. It emphasizes multilateral solutions to problems through bodies like the UN and believes in resolving differences through respectful dialogue. Azerbaijan also values its partnerships and sees engagement with Europe as mutually beneficial, whether on economic, political or security issues. At the same time, it asserts the right to sovereignty and self-determination as a key principle.
