

The Morso Squirrel Stove

The Morso Squirrel Stove 1430 is actually a multi-fuel stove that is an up to date version of the Squirrel 1410 and a great addition to the 1400 selection. It features a number of valuable features including stay clean glass which cleans on its own through a burning and air wash method. Ash from previous fires is handily taken from the stove due to the inclusion of an ash pan. The unit also includes heat shields which can be placed underneath the stove and at the rear which will totally shield areas around it.

Morso is a Danish company that have been manufacturing stoves since 1853, so any person purchasing one of the 1400 range can be certain that they are buying a high quality product that is long lasting, hard wearing and will offer each of the features that they are looking for in a stove. Along with the stoves themselves, Morso provide a range of add-ons that supplement them and improve the way they function.

This stove is extremely preferred for usage on small boats due to its small size. It's also extremely efficient at burning up fuel and there are lots of various fuels which you can use including coal,



wood and smokeless energy sources. Which means that there are a number of methods that the stove may be kept alight for the extended time frame, which is suitable for people who are spending at least a few days on their narrow boat during a period of year when the weather is colder. The stove gets hot swiftly to provide extra warmth as required. Convenience of where the stove is placed is offered because the flue outlet can be either applied on top or the back of the unit.

As mentioned earlier, numerous accessories are available for this stove. Coal inserts can be utilized if this type of fuel is being used in the fire, and they will help make the stove much more efficient. The attachements make the firebox smaller, permitting less fuel to be burned while still sustaining a hot temperature. This simply means the temperature that is needed for heating the room continues to be produced through the stove despite the fact that significantly less fuel is being utilized.

As mentioned previously, a number of accessories are accessible for this stove. Coal inserts can be utilized if this type of fuel is being used in the fire, and these will make the stove a lot

more effective. The inserts make the firebox smaller, allowing a lot less fuel to be burnt while still preserving a hot temperature. This simply means the temperature that is required for heating the area is still produced by the stove despite the fact that less fuel will be used.

Baffle plates can also be used to help make the stove more efficient. These are placed on the firebox on the inside of the stove. The direct exit to the chimney is blocked off by this plate which causes the flue gases to travel a further distance before they can escape the stove. The more the flue gases can be in the firebox, the more heat which will be transferred to the stove while the gases have a greater chance of mixing with air in the stove and fully combusting.

Overall, if you are searching for an efficient stove, whether it be for the watercraft or your home, the Morso Squirrel Stove is the ideal option for you.
