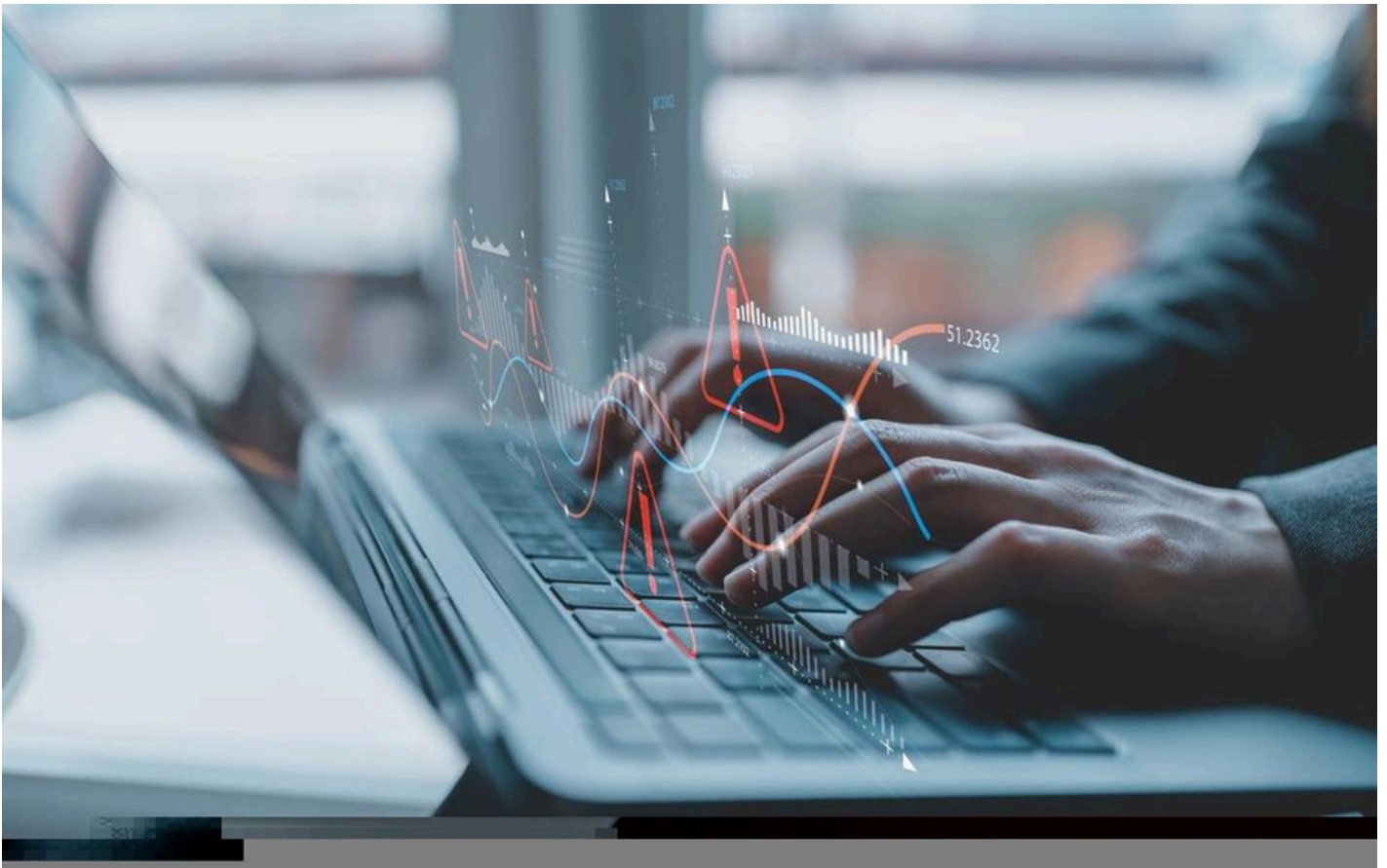




## Could Stop-Loss Orders Be Wasting Your Time in Overtraded Stocks?
