

Keratoconus

Keratoconus is an eye condition in which your cornea (the clear, dome-shaped front of your eye) gets thinner and gradually bulges outward into a cone shape.

A cone-shaped cornea causes blurred vision and may cause sensitivity to light and glare. Keratoconus usually affects both eyes. Symptoms of keratoconus may change as the disease progresses.

Common Symptoms:

- Blurred or distorted vision
- Increased sensitivity to light
- Frequent changes in prescription glasses or contact lenses
- Difficulty with night vision

Diagnosis:

An eye care professional can diagnose keratoconus through a comprehensive eye exam, corneal mapping, and other specialized tests.

Treatment Options:

1- Glasses or Contact Lenses:

• In the early stages, eyeglasses or soft contact lenses may be sufficient to correct vision.

2- Rigid Gas Permeable (RGP) Contact Lenses:

 RGP lenses can provide better visual acuity by compensating for the corneal irregularities.

3- Corneal Cross-Linking (CXL):

• A minimally invasive procedure that strengthens the cornea using UV light and riboflavin eye drops, aiming to slow or halt progression.

4- Intacs:

• Small, curved devices implanted into the cornea to help reshape it and improve vision.

5- Corneal Transplant (Penetrating Keratoplasty or DALK):

• In advanced cases, a corneal transplant may be recommended to replace the damaged cornea with a healthy donor cornea.
